Materials needed

- Certificates for the children
- Certificates for the teachers
- Candles for the teachers and older children
- Mini flashlights for the younger children
- Christ Candle
- Copies of "A Prayer for our Children" for each person in the congregation.

How It Worked

- We first created certificates printed on decorative paper for the children (samples on the following pages) We left the names blank since we never know which children will be here and we filled them in as the children arrived.
- We created cards with the dedication on it for the teachers to read and certificates of commitment for the teachers to sign.
- The room was set of up a large candle for each teacher with a Christ candle in the center. The candles/lights for the children were in a basket on the side. The certificates were also on the table.
- Once everyone had arrived I began bysharing a reading to set the tone. We then
 called each teacher up individually. As they came forward they lit a candle and
 received the card with the dedication on it. Once all the teachers were standing in
 the front they were invited to read the dedication together.
- Next we called the children one by one (we used the certificates to call them up in random order) to come up, light their candle and receive their certificate and then stand with their teacher.
- When that was completed we invited the congregation to join us in reading, "A Prayer for Our Children." The minister then closed with a special blessing.
- We then all enjoyed an Ice Cream Social.

OPENING READING - TO THE CONGREGATION

Teaching is a consecrated service. We place all the children in the light of God.


We call forth from within them the power of God.


We see in each child the presence of God.
